General Information

Host

WoidLa24 is organized by the Lower Austria Association of Girl Guides and Boy Scouts of Austria (member of PPÖ). PPÖ is recognized by the two world organizations, World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGGS) and World Organization of the Scout Movement (WOSM).

Campsite

The campsite is located in the heart of the beautiful Waldviertel region on the premises of Schloss Waldreichs, not far from the Dobra and Ottenstein reservoirs.

Participants

We are expecting about 3,800 local, national and international girl guides and boy scouts who will spend the ten-day camp in sub-camps according to age groups:

- Guides & Scouts (10-13 years old) from Austria and other German-speaking countries
- Caravelles & Explorers (13-16 years old) from all over the world
- Rangers & Rovers (16-20 years old) from all over the world

Costs

The WoidLa24 camp fees:

- € 390.- GUSP (10-13 years old)
- € 420.- CAEX (13-16 years old)
- € 420.- RARO (16-20 years old)
- \in 170.- staff members (18 years and older) and leaders (reduced fee)

Non-reduced fees apply to leaders who do not qualify for the reduced fee (see below). An exception is made for leaders who participate in the camp with their adolescentsscouts and agree to contribute to the sub-camp program. They also pay the reduced fee.

Key to the reduced camp fee for leaders per age group:

- 2 to 6 children/adolescents: 1 leader with reduced fee
- 7 to 12 children/adolescents: 2 leaders with reduced fee
- 13 to 18 children/adolescents: 3 leaders with reduced fee
- For every additional 6 children/adolescents: + 1 leader with reduced fee

Registration

Group pre-registration is possible until September 30, 2023. You can make your reservation through the website <u>www.woidla24.at</u>. Changes and additions can be

made at any time using our self-administration tool. The login details will be sent to the email address provided in the registration form.

Please transfer the deposit of € 100,- per group to our account (free of charge to the recipient) by September 30, 2023 (bank details: IBAN: AT09 1200 0521 0011 1555 BIC: BKAUATWW Unicredit Bank Austria AG).

The group pre-registration will only be registered once the deposit has been received. Detailed group registration will start in the autumn of 2023, but can also be done immediately. A fixed registration is possible as long as there are available spots, but no later than January 31, 2024.

Payment plan

September 2023	Deposit of € 100,- / group
April 2024	Advance payment of € 100,- / person
May 2024	Remaining payment, settlement of camp fee
August 2024	Final settlement at check-in

Cancellation policy

Cancellations made until April 30, 2024 are free of charge. After that, the following cancellation fees will apply: May 2024 – June 30, 2024 50 % of the camp fee from June 30, 2024 100 % of the camp fee

No refunds are possible in cases of early departure of participants.

Arrival and departure

The campsite can be reached by train and public busses. There are no parking spaces available at the campsite. Upon request, we offer a shuttle service between the train stations Krems an der Donau, Göpfritz an der Wild, and the campsite. Costs for the shuttle service are not included in the camp fee. We strive to keep this additional charge as low as possible. As sustainable travel is important to us, the groups with the lowest CO₂ emissions during their journey (per person per kilometer) will be rewarded.

August 5, 2024 is scheduled as day of arrival. Delivery of equipment is possible on August 4, but we can not be held responsible for it. Overnight stay at the assigned campsite is possible for individuals who deliver camp equipment. After setting up the camp, the grand opening ceremony for all participants will take place on the evening of August 5. The program will end with the closing ceremony on the evening of August 14. Departure will take place after dismantling the camp on August 15, 2024.

Equipment

Each group must consider that their participants are divided into different subcamps, according to their age group. Therefore, each patrol (approximately 5 to 7 children/adolescents) must bring the necessary equipment (tents, cooking equipment, etc.) to each sub-camp. Tables, cooking facilities, and other camp structures are to be built by the groups themselves. The necessary building material will be provided in sufficient quantity. Information on possible camp structures can be found in the camp handbook at the camp and soon on <u>www.woidla24.at</u>.

Responsibility of the leaders

Adult leaders are required in all age groups since the children and adolescents are accommodated in different sub-camps. The leaders will assist in the camp program design and implementation according to the age-specific method and will be responsible for the day-to-day camp life of the children and adolescents in their group. One leader per patrol is required.

Too many Leaders? Underutilized?

As a part-time staff member at WoidLa24, you have the opportunity to spend time with your group and have meals together, while also benefiting from a reduced camp fee due to your fixed commitment. At check-in, you will receive a schedule with your tasks and contact persons.

Catering

At WoidLa24, we will largely provide you with regional products, putting a particular focus on sustainability. Cooking will be done in patrols and on open fires (sufficient firewood is available) or on gas stoves brought by the participants (gas cylinders are available at the campsite). From the arrival day on August 5, 2024 evening to the departure day on August 15, 2024 noon, participants will be provided with groceries for their meals.

In your cooking units, you can process the provided groceries into delicious dishes directly on your cooking facilities. We will do our best to adjust the meal plan to the program and aim to offer you a pleasant, nutritious, and diverse cooking and dining experience.

Languages at the camp

The "camp language" is the language in which all organizational information and program points are provided. For Guides and Scouts (10-13 years), the camp language is exclusively German, while for Caravelles and Explorers (13-16 years) and Rangers and Rovers (16-20 years), German and English are equal camp languages.

Sustainability

Sustainability at WoidLa24 should not just be a buzzword or a checklist item. In every aspect of our shared camp, we strive to find and implement the best solutions within our means, in order to create a great camp experience for all of us – in harmony with the available resources. However, this does not mean that we have to relinquish

anything at this camp. On the contrary, the spacious campsite in Waldreichs in the heart of the Waldviertel region with direct access to the Dobra Reservoir offers us numerous opportunities to experience adventurous and unforgettable camp days in its untouched nature. The Waldviertel region has no shortage of tourist attractions, sporting activities, forest hiking trails, or culinary delights. For this reason, we will not leave the Waldviertel region for excursions during WoidLa24 and will utilize the region's resources for our activities as well as our catering.

We are looking forward to living sustainability together with you at WoidLa24.

Guides & Späher (10 – 13 years)

Guides and Späher will live in the "WunderWoid". This age group is open for Austrian and other German-Speaking participants

Caravelles & Explorers (13 – 16 years)
